

SAVE TEMECULA

FIGHT THE POWERLINK

San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) plans to run a corridor of extra-high voltage, 500kV transmission towers through our peaceful Temecula neighborhoods and into our scenic hills. The proposed towers would be up to 200 feet tall (as tall as a 20-story building) and provide no direct benefit to Temecula residents.



WHAT'S AT STAKE

- **Wildfire catastrophe** - increased ignition risk, blocked evacuation routes, and crippled firefighting capability.
- **Property values collapse** - homes near transmission towers lose value.
- **Insurance nightmare** - homeowners insurance is even more difficult to secure or afford.
- **Habitat devastation** - towers run through Temecula Creek, the Santa Margarita River, and our pristine hills, harming wildlife and delicate ecosystems.
- **Economic disaster** - damage to Temecula's robust economy, including local tourism and businesses.
- **Stolen views and vistas** - towers permanently alter Temecula's landscape and character.
- **Cancer risk** - EMF exposure that the World Health Organization cautions as possibly cancer-causing.
- **Noise pollution** - transmission lines buzz and hum, disrupting the peace of our neighborhoods.
